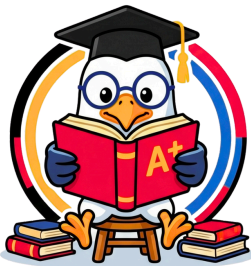

She does the dishes after dinner.

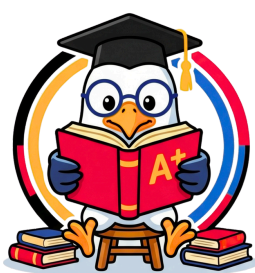
We take out the trash at night.
