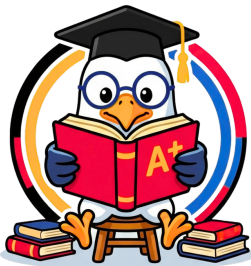

school	place to learn	colegio



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Pronunciation help

- **straight** sounds like "streit"
- **right** sounds like "rait"
- **left** sounds like "left"
- **cross** sounds like "cros"

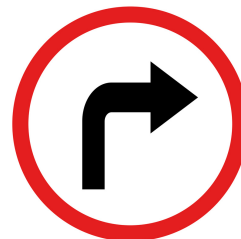
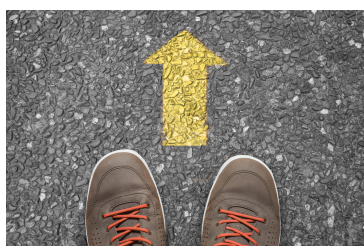
Grammar in a Tiny Box

Direction Verbs

- Go straight.
- Turn left.
- Turn right.
- Cross the road.

Asking for Directions

Use: **Excuse me, where is the park?**
Excuse me, how do I get to the museum?

Giving Directions

Use: **Go straight.**
Turn left at the school.
The park is next to the bank.

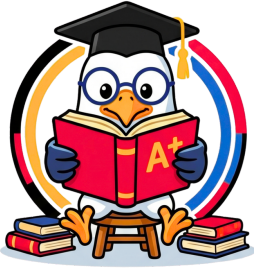


Tiny mistake tip:

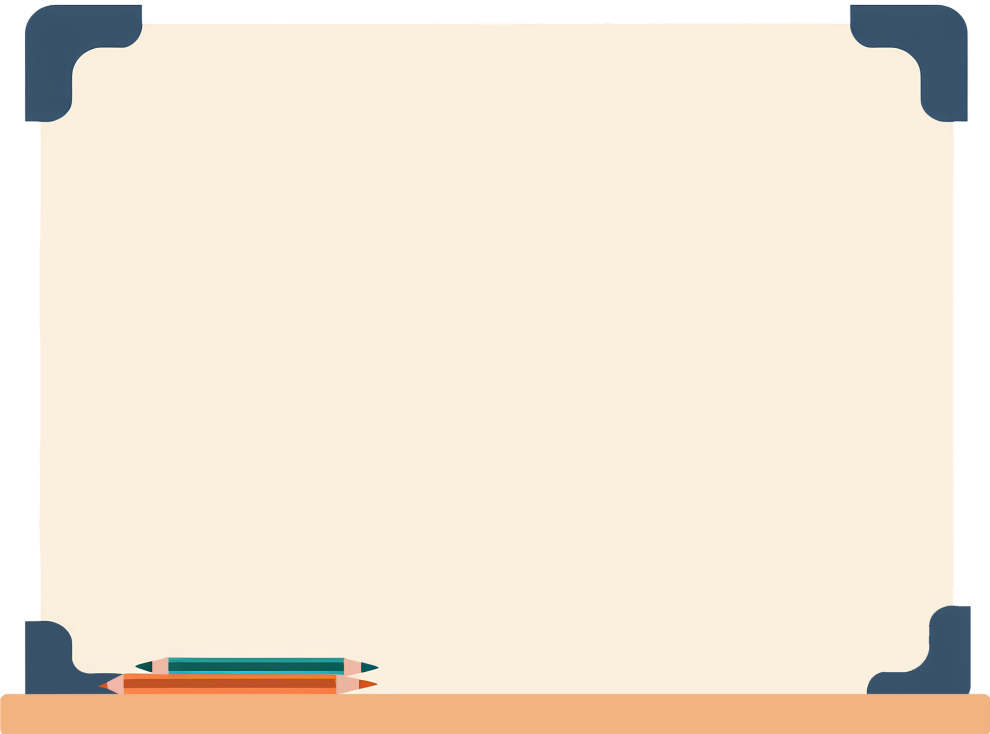
